Neuschafer Community Library Board Personnel and Policies Committee August 18, 2025 Minutes

Bailey called the meeting to order at 1:08pm. Present: D'Arcy, Hernandez, Bailey and Krause

1. Discuss library benchmarking resources & compensation structure for possible pay schedule development

- Krause shared Palantine library's benchmark and compensation structure development plan. The committee reviewed proposed structuring for staff over the next 3 years (which would include the transition to the new building).

2. Update and recommend library staff positions & job descriptions

*Goal is to complete three core job descriptions to have on file:

- 1. Library Director Reviewed and completed description to present to the Board for final approval for September meeting.
- 2. Technical Services Technician Reviewed what was approved by the Board on 12-19-24
- 3. Patron Services Coordinator (for BA/experience)/Program Technician (if no degree). Began drafting job description. Krause will review with staff. May include reviewing remote job duties (future committee meeting agenda item).

3. Recommend 2026 general wage adjustment considerations

- Krause and/or the Finance Committee will connect with the Village to discuss outstanding budget questions (maintenance and utilities) prior to the next meeting.
- Reviewed customary compensation practices and General Wage Adjustment considerations - will discuss with whole Board at September meeting

4. Discuss and recommend benefits for total compensation package

- Reviewed Village Profit and Loss statements medical bonuses were offered to the Village Clerk from at least 2010-2013 (increasing over time from \$1,200 to \$1,500) Don't have enough documentation to know when this stopped/changed.
- Records show that Health Insurance for the Village Clerk was approved to be budgeted for 2022 fiscal year at the amount of \$10,092.83.
- Also, in 2022 Police Health Insurance was budgeted for \$20,185.65 but unfulfilled in the actual year. Court transcripts may provide more details on this.
- Discussed pros and cons of "medical bonus" versus health insurance packages (which you need at least two participants for to enroll).
